Because some insurance agents/underwriters may be concerned about the term "racing" we suggest you provide the following information.

The Sport Air Racing League consists of a group of pilots who fly timed cross-country Races/Rallies hosted by one of its members. Our history of competing since 2007 without any incidents is based on several factors including:

- 1. Races/Rallies are flights typically taking off and landing at one airport and having 5-7 turns.**
- 2. They are designed to be completed in one hour or less.**
- 3. Flying is only done in day vfr conditions and must follow all FAR's**
- 4. Pilots must attend a safety briefing before each race/rally.**

The league focuses on fun and safety. We want to improve pilot skills and build awareness in aviation at all our events.
